GPC Mission Trips

At our recent Session retreat, we noted some important changes that are taking place in our mission trips. In some cases, leaders and long-time participants are "aging out." We've noticed this particularly with the Honduras trip. Younger people aren't replacing those who are retiring. In the case of our South Dakota trip, problems on the ground on the reservation have made it impossible for us to go the last two summers. Both the South Carolina and Mexico trips scrambled to find enough participants this year.

Mission trips are an important part of the identity and mission of GPC. Therefore, we are exploring adding some new kinds of trips that might appeal to different people. For example: week-long trips closer to home, weekend trips, family mission trips, one-day mission experiences, and even a church-wide mission Sunday with something for everyone!


