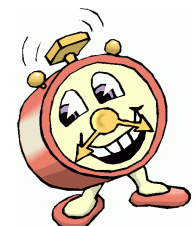

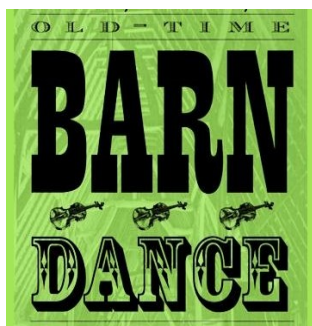

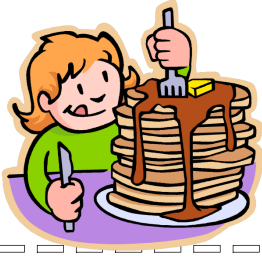


**CHURCH WOMEN UNITED
