Richard Rohr, a Franciscan priest who founded and runs the Center for Contemplation and Action in New Mexico, believes that "people at any age must know about the whole arc of their life and where it is trending and leading."

On Sunday, April 8 we will begin a Sunday morning adult education class running for three weeks based on living our lives fully while developing our spiritual selves, whichever half we are in! Rohr's book, *Falling Upward: A Spirituality for the Two Halves of Life*, will anchor the discussion. Other resources will be utilized to help shape a three-week class exploring the chapters of life, learning from the times we have fallen, and embracing the promises and challenges of life's second half.

### BLESSING BOX

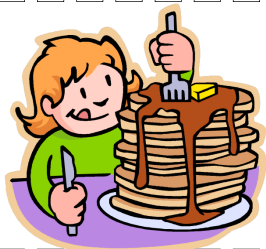
