Session Update...

At a called meeting on Sunday, May 20, the Session approved an addendum to our sales contract with the Gettysburg Area School District regarding the Wall Alley property, decreasing the size of the parcel by about 30% and decreasing the purchase price by the same amount. The Session also approved a new storm water management system required by the school board that will be more costly to the church. The school board approved the addendum on Monday, May 21st. The total number of projected parking spaces remains unchanged at 24. We hope to bring the plans to the borough council for approval in June.
