- · Listen to you
- Pray with you (and for you)
- Assess to see what ministries of the church (meals, support, and transportation) are available to help the parishioner and their families
- Faith Community Nurse promotes a "safe" place.

Some members may feel uncomfortable about going to the Doctor or uncertain their complaint is worthy, but are willing to share it with the nurse.

If you would like me to attend a Doctors appt and be your ears and eyes I would be happy to do so. Please reach out to me to schedule.


