Are you able to answer those kinds of questions with confidence?

Can you speak about the things you believe in a clear and concise way?

Or, in this world where everyone is eager to share his or her ideas, do you find yourself moving from this idea to that, questioning the things that you always thought were important, finding yourself less and less sure about where you stand on issues of faith?

If any of the above resonates with you, the newest adult education class at GPC could be the place for you. It's called <u>Christian Believer</u> and it will give you the opportunity to consider in depth some of the most vital and important tenets of the Christian faith using resources such as scripture, church history, philosophy, personal experiences of others, and your own reflections. The leader of the class will be the Reverend Nancy Davis, a retired United Methodist pastor, who has been leading classes in the Disciple Bible study series, to which the Christian Believer study belongs, for more than twenty years. Rev. Davis and her husband, the Reverend Bruce Davis, also a retired UMC pastor, have lived in Gettysburg only about a year, but have made GPC their church home.

The class will begin after Labor Day. More information will follow soon. Please give this class your most prayerful consideration. A strong faith is vitally important to followers of Jesus Christ and every now and then we all need to remind ourselves what our faith is all about. Perhaps now is the time for you to do just that.

There will also be opportunities for sharing prayer requests and lots of fellowship and fun!


We can always use volunteers to help with the food and welcoming people.


