
With one another & with God, let us embark on the journey of 2021 – this something new and let us *trust the magic of beginnings*.

Per Capita

The blue envelope labeled "PER CAPITA APPORTIONMENT" found near the front of your offering envelope box is a special offering that is not used by GPC. Per capita is an amount of money per member (\$27.20 for 2021) that our congregation pays to our larger Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). This money is part of the glue that holds Presbyterians together as a connectional church and links the individual church, Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly. Per capita amounts are determined by General Assembly nationally, regionally by the Synod and locally by the Presbytery. These monies are used to administer the responsibilities, functions, and mission of each governing body. A major portion of the per capita is used for mission.

Presbytery	\$15.85

Per Capita funding serves and resources your church as it:

- Maintains a physical office and staff at all three levels of governance.
- Provides training and leadership development for your church officers, learning opportunities for pastors and members of
 congregations, and faith formation initiatives for youth through Camp Krislund, Youth Triennium, and other special events.
- Supports the health and well-being of congregations with tools and guidance for congregations searching for a pastor, assistance with conflict resolution, as well as property issues, loans, insurance and record-keeping.
- Provides oversight and preparation for those discerning God's call to ministry.
- Supports and directs the administration of your congregation's participation in mission funding and hands-on mission initiatives.
- Strengthens your congregation's connections to the wider church through:
 - ♦ Commissioners elected to bi-annual General Assembly meetings,
 - ♦ Support of the Presbyterian Historical Society in Philadelphia, and
 - ♦ Participation in the life of the Church Universal, as we seek to work and live in fellowship with "all persons in every nation."

The breakdown of GPC's 2021 per capita share is shown in the table above. The Session is requesting that each member consider making a special offering of \$27.20 per member this month in the envelope provided as their share of GPC's per capita to reduce the impact on the regular offerings that support the annual church budget. Thank you for your faithfulness in giving.

Pass It On

Are you wondering if your tithes and offerings are still being put to good use, even though COVID has caused a post-ponement of many of GPC's programs and mission trips? Well, wonder no more! The Mission and Interpretation committee is happy to announce that we started working in November to determine the best way to use funds that were budgeted for those cancelled mission trips. In December, we brought a proposal to Session, which re-allocated those budgeted funds for needs that were unforeseen pre-COVID. Session unanimously voted to accept the re-allocation, and GPC distributed funds to the following:

- Gettysburg C.A.R.E.S. received funds to help cover motel fees and breakfast costs since they cannot house the homeless in their normal fashion during winter months.
- South Central Community Action Programs received funds for their homeless shelter
- Adams Rescue Mission received funds to help with housing and food needs.
- Presbyterian Disaster Assistance received funds to specifically help with those in the US that have lost everything due to the wildfires out west.
- Accion, the outfit that normally hosts our Mexico Mission trip, received funds to provide food aid for our Mexican neighbors that have been hit triple by COVID, flooding, and hurricanes in 2020.
- Cool Shade of Life Church in Thailand, associated with our Thailand missionaries Bryan and Emily Gerlach, received funds to help purchase land to build a permanent building to anchor their Christian community. (They have been rotating meetings and worship services among member's homes as they have shared the gospel and grown.)

I am proud of our church members' commitments to their pledges and large hearts that have allowed GPC to help those in need shoulder the effects of COVID in 2020. We are God's hands and feet, and no virus will derail us from our mission of spreading God's love!
