The GPC Missions Team is sponsoring a team from our church to participate in the Central PA Walk for Water on Saturday, June 1st, 2024 from 9-11am. This year's walk will be held close by at <u>Oakside Park</u>, <u>Biglerville</u>, <u>PA</u>.

We will walk about one mile carrying empty buckets, fill them from a local stream, then carry them back to the start point and empty the dirty water into a receiving cistern. From there you will see the science of clean water in action as the Water Missions unit transforms our stream water into clean, healthy water that you can try!

Families, adults, youth and children are welcome to participate! Even if you can't walk with us, please register to support our team, and plan to come out to send us on our way and cheer us when we return!
