DIY Hand Sanitizer

Materials:

2/3 cup rubbing alcohol of at least 70% alcohol concentration (CDC states alcohol content must be at least 60%)

1/3 cup Aloe Vera

Simply stir the aloe vera gel and alcohol until they are well blended and then pour the mixture into a bottle of your choice.

Optional: Add a few drops of your favorite essential oil while mixing. This will not have any effect on the potency of your sanitizer, just adds a fragrance.

DIY Reusable Disinfectant Wipes

Materials:

2 cups rubbing alcohol

2-3 tsp Dawn

10 drops Lemon Essential Oil

10 Washcloths

Glass jar with sealing lid

Instructions:

- 1. Decide how big you want your wipes to be. You can cut the washcloths in half for smaller jobs.
- 2. Fill your jar with the washcloths.
- 3. In a bowl, mix rubbing alcohol, Dawn, and Lemon Essential Oil.
- 4. Pour the cleaning mix into the jar over the washcloths.
- 5. Put the lid on and use as needed. After your rags are dirty, just throw in the washing machine and remake as necessary.

To use wipes, wipe down hard, non-porous surfaces and leave 10 minutes to dry. Just a reminder to clean the following surfaces: tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, etc.
